CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 1

A CHARTER ORDINANCE EXEMPTING THE CITY OF WESTWOOD HILLS, KANSAS,
FROM THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 2, CHAPTER 25, OF KANSAS STATUTES
ANNOTATED AND THOSE RELATED SECTIONS OF THE 1968 SESSION LAWS OF
THE STATE OF KANSAS REGARDING PRIMARY ELECTIONS FOR CITY OFFICE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WESTWOOD HILLS:

SECTION 1. The City of Westwood Hills, Kansas, mayor-council city
of the third class, by the power vested in it by Article 12, Section
5, of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, hereby elects to
exempt itself from and make inapplicable to it the provisions of
Article 2, Chapter 25, of Kansas Statutes Annotated and those related
sections of the 1968 Session Laws of the State of Kansas regarding
primary elections for city office. Such referenced provisions are
applicable to this city but are not applicable uniformly to all cities.

SECTION 2. There shall be no primary elections for city officers.

SECTION 3. This charter ordinance shall be published once each week
for two consecutive weeks in the official city newspaper.

SECTION 4. This charter ordinance shall take effect sixty-one days after final publication, unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed and a referendum is held on the ordinance as provided in Article 12, Section 5, Subdivision (c) (3) of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, in which case the ordinance shall become effective if approved by a majority of the electors voting thereupon.

PASSED by the governing body, not less than two-thirds of the members-elect voting in favor thereof, the 1 day of Oct - 1973.

PASSED by the governing body, not less than two-thirds of the members elect voting in favor thereof, the 1st day of October, 1973.
