
## WESTWOOD HILLS, KANSAS CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 4



A CHARTER ORDINANCE REPEALING CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 3, WHICH EXEMPTED THE CITY OF WESTWOOD HILLS, KANSAS FROM K.S.A. 15-106, RELATING TO MEETINGS OF THE CITY COUNCIL AND REQUIRED FOUR COUNCILMEN ELECT TO CONSTITUTE A QUORUM

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WESTWOOD HILLS, KANSAS:

Section 1. Exemption Clause. The City of Westwood Hills, Kansas, a mayor-council city of the third class by the authority and power vested in it by Article 12, Section 5, of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, hereby elects to and does make itself subject to the provisions of Section 15-106 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated as amended and in force at the time this charter ordinance takes effect and specifically elects to make itself subject to the quorum provisions of said Section 15-106.

Section 2. Charter Ordinance No. 3 adopted on May 6, 2002 covering the subject of meetings and quorum requirements is hereby repealed. After the date this Charter Ordinance becomes effective thereby repealing Charter Ordinance No. 3, the City Council shall have the authority to amend Section 1-101 of the City Code by an ordinary ordinance.

Section 3. After the date this Charter Ordinance becomes effective, and until otherwise amended by regular ordinance, Section 1-101 of the Municipal Code of the City of Westwood Hills, Kansas shall be amended to read as follows:

"1-101. MEETINGS. The mayor and councilmen shall have regular sessions on the first Monday of each and every month, at seven o'clock (7:00) p.m. and adjourned sessions at any other time they may deem proper. In case the first Monday of any month falls on a holiday, the regular session shall be held on the next day thereafter which is not a holiday. Special sessions shall be called by the mayor upon the written request of not less than three (3) members of the council, specifying the object and purpose of such meeting, which request shall be read at the meeting and entered at length on the journal. All sessions shall be held at the Westwood City Hall, 4700 Rainbow, Westwood, Kansas, unless circumstances make that place impracticable for a particular session, in which case it may be held at any convenient place within Johnson County. In all cases, it shall require three (3) of the councilmen elect to constitute a quorum to do business, but a smaller number may adjourn from day to day."

Section 4. Publication. This Charter Ordinance shall be published once each week for two (2) consecutive weeks in the official city newspaper.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Charter Ordinance shall take effect sixty-one (61) days after its final publication, unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed and a referendum held on the ordinance as provided by Article 12, Section 5, Subsection (c)(3) of the Constitution of Kansas, in which case the ordinance will become effective if approved by the majority of the electors voting thereon.

Passed by the Governing Body, not less than two-thirds of the members-elect voting in favor thereof, this 4th day of August, 2008.

Section 1. Exemption Clause. After the date this Charter Ordinance becomes effective thereby repealing Charter Ordinance No. 3, the City Council shall have the authority to amend Section 1-101 of the City Code by an ordinary ordinance.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Charter Ordinance shall take effect sixty-one (61) days after its final publication, unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed and a referendum field on the cridinance as provided by Article 12, Section 5, Subsection (c)(3) of the Constitution of Kansas, in which case the ordinance will become effective if approved by the majority of the electors voting thereon.

Passed by the Governing Body, not less than two-thirds of the members-elect voting in

favor thereof, this 4th day of August, 2008.
