

**CITY OF WESTWOOD HILLS, KANSAS
CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 5**

A CHARTER ORDINANCE EXEMPTING THE CITY OF WESTWOOD HILLS, KANSAS, FROM THE PROVISIONS OF L. 2015, CHAPTER 88, SECTION 71, CODIFIED AT K.S.A. 12-104a, RELATING TO THE FILLING OF GOVERNING BODY VACANCIES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WESTWOOD HILLS, KANSAS:

Section 1. The City of Westwood Hills, Kansas, by virtue of the power vested in it by Article 12, Section 5, of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, hereby elects and does exempt itself and make inapplicable to it L. 2015, Chapter 88, Section 71, codified at K.S.A. 12-104a, relating to the filling of governing body vacancies, which enactment applies to this city, but does not apply uniformly to all cities.

Section 2. The City of Westwood Hills, Kansas, shall continue to follow the provisions of the Code of the City of Westwood Hills, Kansas, in particular Chapter 1, Article 5, Section 1-502, relating to the filling of vacancies of the Governing Body.


Section 3. This charter ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the official city newspaper.

Section 4. This charter ordinance shall take effect 61 days after final publication unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed and a referendum held on the ordinance as provided in Article 12, Section 5, Subsection (c)(3) of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, in which case the ordinance shall become effective if approved by the majority of the electors thereon.

Passed by the Governing Body, not less than two-thirds of the members elect voting in favor thereof, this 9th day of May, 2016.




