ISSUANCE OF INTERNAL IMPROVEMENT
BONDS, SERIES 1975, OF THE CITY OF
WESTWOOD HILLS, KANSAS, IN THE
PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF \$246,281.28 FOR THE
PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING CERTAIN
STREET, SIDEWALK, CURB AND GUTTER
IMPROVEMENTS WITHIN THE CITY OF
WESTWOOD HILLS, KANSAS, UNDER THE
PROVISIONS OF K.S.A. 12-6a01 ET SEQ., AND
FIXING THE DETAILS OF SAID BONDS.

WHEREAS, pursuant to proceedings duly had
under K.S.A. 12-6a01, et seq., certain street,
sidewalk, curb and gutter improvements within
the City of Westwood Hills, Kansas were con-
structed, and

now finds and determines that the total cost of
said improvements is \$267,837.10, of which
\$45,532.31 is chargeable to the City at large and
\$222,304.79 is chargeable to the property liable to

City's general improvement fund, leaving un-
paid the amount of \$246,281.28, and
