

ORDINANCE NO. 12

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO APPOINTMENT AND DUTIES OF CITY ATTORNEY.

Be it ordained by the governing body of The City of Westwood Hills:

REPEAL OF SECTION: Section 1. Section 1-405 of Revised Ordinance (Section 5 of Ordinance No. 4) is hereby repealed and the following section is hereby enacted in lieu thereof:

1-405 DUTIES OF THE CITY ATTORNEY. Section 5. It shall be the duty of the City Attorney to attend, so far as reasonably possible, all meetings of the city council, during his term; to furnish advice on legal points to the mayor, city council, city officers and employees concerning city business; to aid the ordinance committee in drawing ordinances; to draw contracts and such other instruments as may be necessary for city business; to prosecute such matters as may be necessary before the local police court in connection with said city affairs; to attend hearings before the County Commissioners and the State Boards when directed by the mayor and city council, and to represent the city generally in legal matters.

TAKE EFFECT. Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication.
