

ORDINANCE NO. 125

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR AND CALLING FOR AN ELECTION FOR THE CITY OF WESTWOOD HILLS, KANSAS, TO VOTE ON THE PROPOSITION OF ELIMINATING THE INTANGIBLE TAX IN SAID CITY AND AUTHORIZING THE IMPOSITION OF ADDITIONAL PROPERTY TAXES TO OFFSET THE REVENUE LOST FROM ELIMINATION OF THE INTANGIBLE TAX

WHEREAS, 1982 H.B. 3142 provides in part that on or after January 1, 1983, upon submission of a petition signed by not less than five percent (5%) of the qualified electors of the City requesting the elimination of the intangibles tax and the imposition of additional property taxes to offset the revenue lost from elimination of the intangible tax, the governing body shall be required to submit the proposition to the electors at the next primary or general election; and

WHEREAS, a petition has been submitted and has been deemed adequate by the governing body to cause such election to be held and the proposition submitted.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WESTWOOD HILLS, KANSAS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It has been deemed and declared to be necessary to call an election of the voters of said city to be held on the 5th day of April, 1983, for the purpose of submitting to the electors the following proposition:

Shall the City of Westwood Hills, Kansas eliminate the tax on gross earnings derived from money, notes and other evidence of debt and be authorized to impose and levy property taxes, in addition to any aggregate levy amount limitation on the taxing subdivision's ad valorem tax levy authority, as may be necessary to offset the revenue lost from elimination of the tax on gross earnings derived from money, notes and other evidence of debt?

Section 2. Said election shall be held on Tuesday, April 5, 1983, and the polling place for said election will be as follows:
