TOTAL CITY RETAILERS' SALES TAX ONE PERCENT

Whereas, pursuant to Kansas Statutes Annotated 12-187 as amended in 1983 by Senate Bill No. 410, cities may impose an additional retailers' sales tax of .5% by submitting such proposition to and having received the approval of the majority of the electors of the city voting on the question, and

Whereas, the question was submitted to the electorate of the city of Westwood Hills, Kansas, at an election held on the 8th day of November, 1983, and

Whereas, on the 8th day of November, 1983, a majority of the electors voting thereon approved the implementation of an additional retailers' sale tax of one-half percent (.5%) making the total city retailers' sales tax 1%.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WESTWOOD HILLS, KANSAS:


Section 1. There is hereby implemented an additional city retailers' sales tax of one-half of one percent (.5%), making the total city retailers' sales tax one percent (1%), in the City of Westwood Hills, Kansas effective February 1, 1984.

Section 2. That after publication, the City Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this ordinance to the State Director of Taxation, Topeka, Kansas

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper.



Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper.



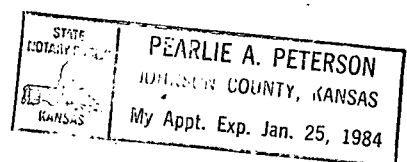

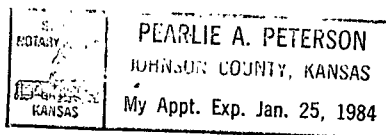
