There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating traffic within the corporate limits of the City of Westwood Hills, Kansas, Chapter 8 of Kansas Statutes Annotated as amended by the 1985 Session Laws and the 1985 Supplement thereto, when published, save and except such articles, sections, parts or portions as are hereafter omitted, deleted, modified or changed, such incorporation being authorized by K.S.A. 12-3009 through K.S.A. 12-3012. Not less than three (3) copies of said "Chapter 8 of Kansas Statutes Annotated" shall be marked or stamped, "Official Copy as incorporated by reference by Section 11-101 of the Code of the City of Westwood Hills, Kansas", with all sec-tions or portions thereof intended to be omitted or changed clearly marked to show any such omission or change, and filed with the city clerk to be opened to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours. The police depart-ment, municipal judge, and all administrative departments of the city charged with the enforcement of the ordinances, shall be supplied, at the cost of the city, such number of offical copies of such "Chapter 8 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated" similarly marked, deleted and changed, as may be deemed expedient."

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its publication once in the official City newspaper.
