Ordinance No. 134

Whereas, the City of Westwood Hills, Kansas, has adopted Chapter 8 of Kansas Statutes Annotated as its traffic ordinance within the City, and

Whereas, the legislature adopted amendments to said Chapter 8, which amendments became effective July 1, 1985, and

Whereas, the governing body desires to incorporate those amendments within its municipal code.


Now, therefore, be it ordained by the governing body of the City of Westwood Hills, Kansas:

Section 1. Section 11-101 of the Code of the City of Westwood Hills, Kansas, 1979 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"11-101. STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE INCORPORATED BY REFERENCE. There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating traffic within the corporate limits of the City of Westwood Hills, Kansas, Chapter 8 of Kansas Statutes Annotated as amended by the 1985 Session Laws and the 1985 Supplement thereto, when published, save and except such articles, sections, parts or portions as are hereafter omitted, deleted, modified or changed, such incorporation being authorized by K.S.A. 12-3009 through K.S.A. 12-3012. Not less than three (3) copies of said "Chapter 8 of Kansas Statutes Annotated" shall be marked or stamped, "Official Copy as incorporated by reference by Section 11-101 of the Code of the City of Westwood Hills, Kansas", with all sections or portions thereof intended to be omitted or changed clearly marked to show any such omission or change, and filed with the city clerk to be opened to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours. The police department, municipal judge, and all administrative departments of the city charged with the enforcement of the ordinances, shall be supplied, at the cost of the city, such number of official copies of such "Chapter 8 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated" similarly marked, deleted and changed, as may be deemed expedient."

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its publication once in the official City newspaper.
