CITY OF WESTWOOD HILLS, KANSAS ORDINANCE NO. 158

WHEREAS, the Governing Body has by Charter Ordinance exempted the City of Westwood Hills, Kansas from the provisions of K.S.A. 12-4112, and

WHEREAS, The Governing Body has determined that it is advisable to amend the Municipal Code of the City to add a provision for the assessment of court costs in all cases filed in the Municipal Court of the City of Westwood Hills, Kansas, to help defray the costs associated with the operation of said court.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WESTWOOD HILLS, KANSAS, as follows:

Section 1. Section 9-113 of the Code of the City of Westwood Hills is hereby amended to read as follows:

9-113. COSTS. In addition to witness fees, mileage and assessments as provided by state statute, the imposition of which the Court is authorized to impose as costs, in each case filed in the Municipal Court of Westwood Hills, Kansas, in which the defendant waives appearance and enters a plea of guilty, the defendant enters a plea of guilty upon appearance, or the defendant is found guilty, the Court shall assess court costs in the amendant of \$5.00 for such case.
