

ORDINANCE NO. 16

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE APPOINTMENT OF OFFICIAL DEPOSITORY AND BOND.

Be it ordained by the governing body of The City of Westwood Hills:


1-801 APPOINTMENT OF OFFICIAL DEPOSITORY, Section 1. There being no bank within the city limits of the city, the Johnson County National Bank and Trust Company, Prairie Village, Post Office address, Mission, Kansas, a national bank within Johnson County, Kansas, is hereby designated as the official depository of the city and the City Treasurer is authorized and directed to deposit all public funds coming into his hands as City Treasurer, in said bank, upon its furnishing satisfactory bond or other security.

1-802 BOND, Section 2. The official depository shall furnish a bond to the city as provided in Section 1-801 in the amount of \$5,000.00, said bond being conditioned that the depository shall pay promptly any orders drawn upon it for moneys deposited with said bank, said bond to be in form approved by the City Attorney.

TAKE EFFECT, Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication.


