AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
CHAPTER 10 OF THE
WESTWOOD HILLS MU-
NICIPAL CODE BY
AMENDING SECTION 10-
101 TO INCORPORATE BY
REFERENCE THE UNI-
FORM PUBLIC OFFENSE
CODE, KANSAS
CITIES EDITION OF 1993
AND REPEALING SECTION
1. OF ORDINANCE NUM-
BERED 160.

WHEREAS, the Gov-
erning Body of Westwood

Hills, Kansas, has de-
termined that it is advisable
to amend Section 101 of
Chapter X of the Municipal
Code of the City to adopt
the most recent edition of
the Uniform Public Offense
Code for Kansas Cities
prepared and published by
The League of Kansas
Municipalities.

NOW, THEREFORE,
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE
GOVERNING BODY OF
THE CITY OF WEST-
WOOD HILLS, KANSAS, as
follows:

Section 1. Section 101
of Chapter X of the Code of
the City of Westwood Hills
is hereby amended to read
as follows:

10-101. INCORPORATING
UNIFORM PUBLIC
OFFENSE CODE. There
is hereby incorporated
by reference for the
purpose of regulating
public offenses within
the corporate limits of
the City of Westwood
Hills, Kansas, that
certain code known as
the "Uniform Public
Offense Code," Edition
of 1993, prepared and
published in book form
by the League of
Kansas Municipalities,
save and except such
articles, sections, parts,
or portions as are
hereafter omitted,
deleted, modified, or
changed, such incorpor-
ation being authorized
by K.S.A. 12-3009
through 12-3012, inclusive,
as amended. No fewer
than three copies of
said standard traffic
ordinance shall be
marked or stamped
"Official Copy as
Incorporated by the
Code of the City of
Westwood Hills, Kansas",
with all sections or
portions thereof intended
to be omitted or
changed clearly marked
to show any such
omission or change and
to which shall be
attached a copy of this
section, and filed with
the City Clerk to be
open to inspection and
available to the public at
all reasonable hours.

Section 2. REPEAL
AND SAVINGS CLAUSE.

Section 1. of Ordinance 160
and all other ordinances
inconsistent herewith are
repealed; however, the
repeal of said ordinances
does not affect any right
which has accrued, any
duty imposed, any penalty
incurred, nor any pro-
ceeding commenced, under
or by virtue of the ordinance
repealed. The provisions of
any ordinance, so far as
they are the same as those
of any prior ordinance, shall
be construed as a con-
tinuation of such provisions,
and not as a new
enactment.

Section 3. This Ordinance
shall be effective upon its
passage, approval by the
Mayor and publication once
in the official city
newspaper.

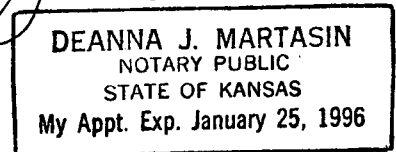

AND REPEALING SECTION
1. OF ORDINANCE NUM-
BERED 160.

WHEREAS, the Gov-
erning Body of Westwood

Hills, Kansas, has de-
termined that it is advisable
to amend Section 101 of
Chapter X of the Municipal
Code of the City to adopt
the most recent edition of
the Uniform Public Offense
Code for Kansas, which was
prepared and published by
The League of Kansas
Municipalities.

NOW, THEREFORE,
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE
GOVERNING BODY OF
THE CITY OF WEST-
WOOD HILLS, KANSAS, as
follows:

Section 1. Section 101
of Chapter X of the Code of
the City of Westwood Hills
is hereby amended to read
as follows:

10-101. INCORPORATING
UNIFORM PUBLIC
OFFENSE CODE. There
is hereby incorporated
by reference for the
purpose of regulating
public offenses within
the corporate limits of
the City of Westwood
Hills, Kansas, that
certain code known as
the "Uniform Public
Offense Code," Edition
of 1993, prepared and
published in book form
by the League of
Kansas Municipalities,
save and except such
articles, sections, parts,
or portions as are
hereafter omitted,
deleted, modified, or
changed, such incorpor-
ation being authorized
by K.S.A. 12-3009
through 12-3012, inclusive,
as amended. No fewer
than three copies of
said standard traffic
ordinance shall be
marked or stamped
"Official Copy as
Incorporated by the
Code of the City of
Westwood Hills, Kansas",
with all sections or
portions thereof intended
to be omitted or
changed clearly marked
to show any such
omission or change and
to which shall be
attached a copy of this
section, and filed with
the City Clerk to be
open to inspection and
available to the public at
all reasonable hours.

Section 2. REPEAL
AND SAVINGS CLAUSE.

Section 1. of Ordinance 160
and all other ordinances
inconsistent herewith are
repealed; however, the
repeal of said ordinances
does not affect any right
which has accrued, any
duty imposed, any penalty
incurred, nor any pro-
ceeding commenced, under
or by virtue of the ordinance
repealed. The provisions of
any ordinance, so far as
they are the same as those
of any prior ordinance, shall
be construed as a con-
tinuation of such provisions,
and not as a new
enactment.

Section 3. This Ordinance
shall be effective upon its
passage, approval by the
Mayor and publication once
in the official city
newspaper.
