

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WEST-WOOD HILLS, KANSAS, as follows:

Section 1. Section 101 of Chapter X of the Code of the City of Westwood Hills is hereby amended to read as follows:

10-101. INCORPORATING UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE. There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating public offenses within the corporate limits of the City of Westwood Hills, Kansas, that certain code known as the "Uniform Public Offense Code," Edition of 1993, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, save and except such articles, sections, parts, or portions as are hereafter omitted, deleted, modified, or changed, such incorporation being authorized by K.S.A. 12-3009 through 12-3012, inclusive, as amended. No fewer than three copies of said standard traffic ordinance shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Incorporated by the Code of the City of Westwood Hills, Kansas", with all sections or portions thereof intended to show any such omission or change and to which shall be attached a copy of this section, and liled with the City Clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours.

Section 2. REPEAL AND SAVINGS CLAUSE. Section 1. of Ordinance 160 and all other ordinances inconsistent herewith are repealed; however, the repeal of said ordinances does not affect any right which has accrued, any duty imposed, any penalty incurred, nor any proceeding commenced under or by virtue of the ordinance repealed. The provisions of any ordinance, so far as they are the same-as those of any prior ordinance, shall be construed as a continuation of such provisions, and not as a new enactment.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage, approval by the Mayor and publication once in the official city newspaper.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WEST-WOOD HILLS, KANSAS, as follows:

Section 1. Section 101 of Chapter X of the Code of the City of Westwood Hills is hereby amended to read as follows:

10-101. INCORPORATING UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE. There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating public offenses within the corporate limits of the City of Westwood Hills, Kansas, that certain code known as the "Uniform Public Offense Code," Edition of 1993, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, save and except such articles, sections, parts, or portions as are hereafter omitted, deleted, modified, or changed, such incorporation being authorized by K.S.A. 12-3009 through 12-3012, inclusive, as amended. No fewer than three copies of said standard traffic ordinance shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Incorporated by the Code of the City of Westwood Hills, Kansas", with all sections or portions thereof intended to be omitted or changed clearly marked to show any such omission or change and to which shall be attached a copy of this section, and filed with the City Clerk to be open in the public at all reasonable hours.

Section 2. REPEAL AND SAVINGS CLAUSE. Section 1. of Ordinance 160 and all other ordinances inconsistent herewith are repealed; however, the repeal of said ordinances does not affect any right which has accrued, any duty imposed, any penaity incurred, nor any proceeding commenced, under or by virtue of the ordinance repealed. The provisions of any ordinance, so far as they are the same, as those of any prior ordinance, shall be construed as a continuation of such provisions, and not as a new enactment.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage, approval by the Mayor and publication once in the official city newspaper.
