## CITY OF WESTWOOD HILLS, KANSAS ORDINANCE NO. 191

WHEREAS, an ordinance must be adopted if the fiscal year 2003 city budget will utilize tax revenues in excess of the revenue utilized in the 2002 city budget and the Governing Body has determined that the year 2003 budget will utilize tax revenues in excess of the revenue utilized in the 2002 city budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WESTWOOD HILLS, KANSAS, as follows:

Section 1. In accordance with state law, the City of Westwood Hills has conducted a public hearing and has published the proposed budget necessary to fund City services from January 1, 2003 until December 31, 2003.

Section 2. After careful public deliberations, the governing body has determined that in order to maintain the public services that are essential for the citizens of this City, it will be necessary to budget property tax revenues in an amount which exceeds such revenues expended in the budget year 2002.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and publication once in the official city newspaper.
