ORDINANCE NO. 206

WHEREAS, pursuant to K.S.A. 79-2925b., an ordinance must be adopted before the governing body can approve a budget for fiscal year 2006 which will utilize tax revenues produced by property taxes in excess of such revenues utilized in the 2005 city budget, and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body has determined that the year 2006 budget will utilize property tax revenues in excess of such revenue utilized in the 2005 city budget.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WESTWOOD HILLS, KANSAS, as follows:

Section 1. In accordance with state law, the City of Westwood Hills has prepared and published the proposed budget necessary to fund City services from January 1, 2006 until December 31, 2006 and has conducted a public hearing on such proposed budget.


Section 2. After careful public deliberations, the governing body has determined that in order to maintain the public services that are essential for the citizens of this City, it will be necessary to adopt a budget for 2006 which will be funded by revenue produced from property taxes in an amount exceeding the amount of revenue produced from property taxes for the 2005 budget year.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and publication once in the official city newspaper.


