NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WESTWOOD HILLS, KANSAS, as follows:

Section 1. Section 9-106 of the Code of the City of Westwood Hills is hereby amended to read as follows:


"9-106. COSTS. In addition to witness fees, mileage and assessments as provided by state statute, the imposition of which the Court is authorized to impose as costs, in each case filed in the Municipal Court of Westwood Hills, Kansas, where there is a finding of guilty or a plea of guilty, a plea of no contest, forfeiture of bond or diversion, the Court shall assess court costs in the amount of \$25.00 for each such case."






