

CITY OF WESTWOOD HILLS, KANSAS
ORDINANCE NO. 241

WHEREAS, the Governing Body has determined that it is advisable to amend the Municipal Code of the City to change the date of the regular meeting of the City Council from the first Monday of each month to the second Monday of each month.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WESTWOOD HILLS, KANSAS, as follows:

Section 1. The first two sentences of Section 1-101 of the Code of the City of Westwood Hills are hereby amended to read as follows:

"The mayor and councilpersons shall have regular sessions on the second Monday of each and every month, at seven o'clock (7:00) p.m. and adjourned sessions at any other time they may deem proper. In case the second Monday of any month falls on a holiday, the regular session shall be held on the next day thereafter which is not a holiday."

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage, approval by the Mayor and publication once in the official city newspaper.


