

ORDINANCE NO. 27

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO ANIMALS AND POULTRY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WESTWOOD HILLS:

ANIMALS AND POULTRY FORBIDDEN. Section 1. No person shall keep, or cause or allow or permit to be kept, on any premises in the city occupied by him or under his charge or control, any live hogs, goats, cattle, sheep, chickens, ducks or geese. Nor shall chickens, ducks, geese or other fowl be allowed to run at large.

VIOLATION. Section 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of Article I of this chapter shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.00 or imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than three months, or by both fine and imprisonment.

TAKING EFFECT. Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication.
