CITY OF WESTWOOD HILLS, KANSAS ORDINANCE NO. 277

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE TERMS OF OFFICE OF ELECTED OFFICERS AND FIRST MEETING OF NEW GOVERNING BODY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WESTWOOD HILLS, KANSAS:

Section 1. Section 3-101 of the Code of the City of Westwood Hills, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

- 3-101 OFFICERS ELECTED; TERM; QUALIFICATIONS. (a) The governing body consists of a mayor and five council members. The mayor and council members shall be residents and qualified electors of the City of Westwood Hills, Kansas. Every two years on the first Tuesday of November of each odd numbered year, an election shall be held for a mayor and five council members. The mayor and council members shall hold their offices for two years and until their successors are elected and qualified.
- (b) The mayor and city council positions that would have expired in January of 2020 shall expire on the day of the first regularly scheduled City Council meeting following the certification of the election results from the November 2019 general election when the mayor and city council members elected in the November 2019 general election shall take office.

In subsequent election cycles, the mayor and city council members elected in a general election shall take office at the first regularly scheduled City Council meeting following the certification of the election results from the general election.

Section 2. The ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately following its adoption and publication as provided by law.
