

ORDINANCE No. 36

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE PARKING OF TRUCKS AND COMMERCIAL VEHICLES

Be it ordained by the governing body of the City of Westwood Hills:

Section 1. No person shall park or leave any truck or commercial vehicle upon any street within the City for more than one hour between sundown of one day and sunrise the following day, except for such period of time as may be necessary for the bona fide delivery of or receipt from a residence or place of business of merchandise or goods.

Section 2. Any person violating Section 1 of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$1.00 or more than \$100.00 and costs, or by confinement in jail for not more than 30 days.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication.
