

ORDINANCE NO. 36^A

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 1-402 REVISED ORDINANCES AND EN-
ACTING IN LIEU THEREOF AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO QUALIFICATIONS
OF CITY OFFICERS AND PROVIDING FOR THEIR OATHS.

Be it ordained by the governing body of the City of Westwood Hills:

Repeal of Section. Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 4 (Sec-
tion 1-402 Revised Ordinances) is hereby repealed and the follow-
ing section is hereby enacted in lieu thereof:


1-402. QUALIFICATION OF CITY OFFICERS; OATH OF OFFICE. The
officers appointed under this article shall be qualified electors
of the City under the constitution and laws of the State of Kansas,
except, however, the city attorney and policemen if they are
exempt from such requirement by any statute of Kansas. They
shall qualify for office by taking and subscribing the following
oath before an officer authorized to administer the same:

"I do solemnly swear (or affirm as the case may be) that
I will support the Constitution of the United States and
the Constitution of the State of Kansas, and faithfully
perform the duties of _____,
so help me God."


TAKE EFFECT: Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be
in force from and after its publication.
