SECTION 2. REGULATION OF TRUCK TRAFFIC.

In lieu of said repealed ordinance the following ordinance is hereby adopted and enacted:

"3-141. REGULATION OF TRUCK TRAFFIC. No truck, commercial vehicle or vehicle other than one carrying passengers or constructed to carry passengers shall be allowed to enter or travel upon 48th Street Terrace, 49th Street, 49th Street Terrace, 50th Street, 50th Street Terrace, Glendale Road or State Line Road, in the City of Westwood Hills; provided that this ordinance shall not apply to any such street until and unless there is erected and maintained upon such street one or more signs indicative of the general purpose of this ordinance; and, provided further, that this ordinance shall not apply to a vehicle carrying goods, merchandise, material or other articles to or from any house, building or premises adjacent to or abutting upon any such street or engaged in the repair, maintenance, construction or servicing of a street, sidewalk, sewer, drain or utility in the City or of a house, building or premises adjacent to or abutting upon any such street."
