

ORDINANCE NO. 40

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE TRAFFIC, AMENDING SECTION 3-137 OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF WESTWOOD HILLS AND REQUIRING DRIVERS OF MOTOR VEHICLES MEETING OR OVERTAKING SCHOOL BUSES TO STOP

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WESTWOOD HILLS:

Section 1. That Section 3-137 of the Revised Ordinances of the City of Westwood Hills entitled "3-137 MEETING OR OVERTAKING SCHOOL BUSES" be amended and altered so as to read:

"3-137 MEETING OR OVERTAKING SCHOOL BUSES. The driver of a vehicle upon any street or highway when meeting or overtaking from either direction any vehicle used and designated as a school bus which has stopped on such street or highway for the purpose of receiving or discharging any school children shall stop the vehicle before reaching such bus whenever a stop signal which meets standard requirements approved by the State Highway Commission of Kansas, shall be displayed from such bus, and said signal shall be due warning to the driver of any approaching vehicle that children may be on the street or highway and which vehicle shall not pass the school bus until such stop signal has been withdrawn."

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication.
