Ordinance No. 43

An Ordinance Providing for the Regular City Election.

Be It Ordained by the governing body of the City of Westwood Hills, Kansas:

Section 1. That the regular city election of the City of Westwood Hills, Kansas, shall be held on Tuesday, April 2, 1957, from the hours of 8:00 o'clock to 6:00 o'clock P. M. in the ^City Hall, 5008 State Line, for the purpose of electing a Mayor, a Police Judge and five Councilmen.
