Ordinance No. 45

An Ordinance relating to barking or howling dogs and dogs putting persons in fear.

Be It Ordained by the governing body of the City of Westwood Hills that:

"Section 1. Barking or howling dogs; dogs putting persons in fear. -No person shall own, keep or harbor any dog or bitch which, by loud, frequent or habitual barking, howling or yelping, shall annoy or disturb any neighborhood or person, or by habitually jumping upon or threatening persons upon public streets shall cause persons thereon to be put in fear of injury."

Section 2. Penalties. Any person violating Section 1 of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by (a) a fine of not less than \$1.00 nor more than \$100.00 and costs or (b) confinement in jail for not more than 30 days.

Section 3. Take Effect. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication.
