ORDINANCE NO. $\qquad$
AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO CITY ELECTIONS, NOTICE THEREOF, AND APPOINTMENT OF JUDGES AND CLERKS.

Be it ordained by the governing body of The City of Westwood H111s:

1-501 ELECTIONS; WHEN HELD; WHAT OFFICERS ELECTED. Section 1. On the first Tuesday in April of every odd numbered year an election shall be held for a mayor, a police judge, and five councilmen.

1-502 PROCLAMATION. Section 2. An ordinance stating the time and place of holding such election, the officers to be elected, and the names of the judges and clerks shall be passed and published at least fifteen days prior to the regular election.

1-503 JUDGES AND CLERKS. Section 3. Preceding the passage of the election ordinance, the mayor shall, with the approval of the council, designate three citizens, not candidates at such election, to act as judges of election; and the council shall designate two citizens, not members of the council, to act as clerks.

TAKE EFFECT. Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication.
