

ORDINANCE NO. 71.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REGULAR CITY ELECTION:

Be it ordained by the governing body of the City of Westwood Hills, Kansas:


SECTION 1. That the regular city election of the City of Westwood Hills, Kansas, shall be held Tuesday, the 4th day of April, 1967, from the hours of 8 A. M. to 6 P. M., at the City Hall, 5008 State Line, for the purpose of electing a mayor, a police judge and five councilmen.

SECTION 2. That Mary Hellige, Adah Taplin and Dorothy Robertson, citizens not candidates for office, are hereby designated by the mayor, with the approval of the council, to act as judges of said election; and Esther Atkisson and Carolyn Hays, citizens, not councilmen, are hereby designated by the council to act as clerks of said election.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official paper of the city.


