<u>SECTION 2</u> Any person who shall violate the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction therefor, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.00, or by imprisonment in the City or County Jail for a period not to exceed three (3) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment for each offense.
