SECTION 2 Nothing herein contained shall be in lieu of any civil damages.

SECTION 3 A violation of any portion of this ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor and upon conviction therefor, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.00, or by imprisonment in the City or County Jail for a period not to exceed three (3) months, or by both fine and imprisonment for each offense.
