AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING LITTERING

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WESTWOOD HILLS, KANSAS:

Section 1. Littering shall be unlawful and any person convicted of littering shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and may be sentenced to pay a fine not to exceed \$100.

Section 2. Littering is dumping, throwing, placing, depositing or leaving, or causing to be dumped, thrown, deposited or left any refuse of any kind or any object or substance which tends to pollute, mar or deface, into, upon or about:]

(a) any public street, highway, alley, road, right-of-way, park or other public place, or any stream, water course or other body of water, except by direction of some public officer or employee authorized by law to direct or permit such acts; or

(b) any private property without the consent of the owner or occupant of such property.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the date of its publication.

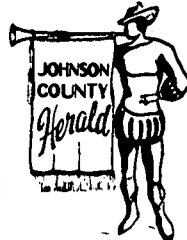

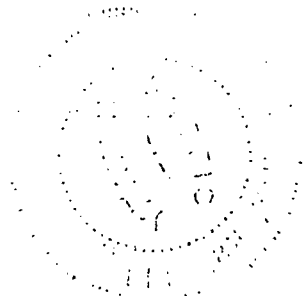
