

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE RECALL OF CITY OFFICIALS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WESTWOOD HILLS:

SECTION I. Every official of the City of Westwood Hills holding office either by election or appointment is subject to recall from office by a majority of the electors of the City voting on the subject at any general or special election, but the provisions hereof shall not be deemed exclusive of other remedies for removal from office.

SECTION II. An election for recall shall be held upon petitions signed by at least twenty-five percent (25%) of the Westwood Hills electors qualified to sign. Every citizen of the United States who has attained the age of eighteen years and who shall have resided in Kansas six months next preceding any election and in the City of Westwood Hills for at least thirty days next preceding such election shall be deemed a qualified elector.

SECTION III. Any petition for recall shall certify that the signers thereto are citizens of the United States of America and voted for the officer to be recalled, if an elected officer, or for the officer who appointed him, if an appointed officer, at the last preceding election at which such officer was elected. Each signature shall be dated.

Recall petitions shall be filed within 30 days of the date of the first signature thereon with the authority for calling elections in Westwood Hills as stipulated below, at least ninety days before the day of election, and the election held thereon shall be called within thirty days after filing petition, and be proclaimed at least sixty days before the date of holding.

The petition and proclamation of election shall state in not more than two hundred words the reasons for recall.

SECTION IV. The authority for calling recall elections in the City of Westwood Hills shall be the City Clerk. Upon receipt of the recall petition, the City Clerk shall validate the authenticity of sufficient signatures on said petition to comprise twenty-five percent (25%) of the Westwood Hills electors qualified to sign. Following such validation and within thirty days after filing of the petition, the City Clerk shall call a special election, which may or may not take place at the same time and place as a general election, to take place sixty days or later from the date of such call.

SECTION V. The recall ballot shall be, Shall the named officer holding the named office be recalled?

SECTION VI. The provisions of law for holding, canvassing and certifying returns of general elections shall apply to recall elections, and if the vote be in favor of the recall, a vacancy in the office shall exist, to be filled as authorized by law.

SECTION VII. Authority. This ordinance is adopted by authority of and under the provisions of Article 12, Section 5 of the Kansas Constitution, and reflects directly the provisions of Article 4 and 5 of the Kansas Constitution.

SECTION VIII. This ordinance shall take effect upon its official publication.

PROOF OF PUBLICATION

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE RECALL OF CITY OFFICIALS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WESTWOOD HILLS:

SECTION I. Every official of the City of Westwood Hills holding office either by election or appointment is subject to recall from office by a majority of the electors of the City voting on the subject at any general or special election, but the provisions hereof shall not be deemed exclusive of other remedies for removal from office.

SECTION II. An election for recall shall be held upon petitions signed by at least twenty-five percent (25%) of the Westwood Hills electors qualified to sign. Every citizen of the United States who has attained the age of eighteen years and who shall have resided in Kansas six months next preceding any election and in the City of Westwood Hills for at least thirty days next preceding such election shall be deemed a qualified elector.

SECTION III. Any petition for recall shall certify that the signers thereto are citizens of the United States of America and voted for the officer to be recalled, if an elected officer, or for the officer who appointed him, if an appointed officer, at the last preceding election at which such officer was elected. Each signature shall be dated.

Recall petitions shall be filed within 30 days of the date of the first signature thereon with the authority for calling elections in Westwood Hills as stipulated below, at least ninety days before the day of election, and the election held thereon shall be called within thirty days after filing petition, and be proclaimed at least sixty days before the date of holding.

The petition and proclamation of election shall state in not more than two hundred words the reasons for recall.

SECTION IV. The authority for calling recall elections in the City of Westwood Hills shall be the City Clerk. Upon receipt of the recall petition, the City Clerk shall validate the authenticity of sufficient signatures on said petition to comprise twenty-five percent (25%) of the Westwood Hills electors qualified to sign. Following such validation and within thirty days after filing of the petition, the City Clerk shall call a special election, which may or may not take place at the same time and place as a general election, to take place sixty days or later from the date of such call.

SECTION V. The recall ballot shall be, Shall the named officer holding the named office be recalled?

SECTION VI. The provisions of law for holding, canvassing and certifying returns of general elections shall apply to recall elections, and if the vote be in favor of the recall, a vacancy in the office shall exist, to be filled as authorized by law.

SECTION VII. Authority. This ordinance is adopted by authority of and under the provisions of Article 12, Section 5 of the Kansas Constitution, and reflects directly the provisions of Article 4 and 5 of the Kansas Constitution.

SECTION VIII. This ordinance shall take effect upon its official publication.
