AN ORDINANCE REVISING ORDINANCE  
NO. 84 RELATING TO DOGS AND CATS.  
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING  
BODY OF THE CITY OF WESTWOOD  
HILLS, KANSAS:

10-202. LICENSE FEES DUE AND  
PAYABLE. Within 60 days after January 1 of  
any calendar year, or acquisition of a dog or  
cat by any resident, or from the date of first  
residence within the city, on from the date the  
dog or cat attains 6 months of age, the owner  
shall obtain a city license and register the  
animal, as provided in Section 10-201 of this  
ordinance. For the first 90 days of delinquency  
hereafter, a penalty of \$2.00 shall be  
charged in addition to the license fee, and for  
any period of delinquency thereafter, a  
penalty of \$10.00 shall be charged in addition  
to the license fee. For the year 1973, only, the  
license fee for cats shall be \$2.00, and the  
license fee for dogs shall remain \$5.00 per  
animal until midnight November 30, 1973. As  
of December 1, 1973, a \$10.00 penalty shall be  
assessed in addition to the license fee, and  
other penalties as designated in Section 10-  
201 of Ordinance No. 84. This ordinance  
repeals and replaces Section 2 of Ordinance  
No. 84, first published in the Johnson County  
Herald on Wednesday, August 1, 1973, and the  
schedule of license fees published therein.

SECTION 10-222 LICENSE FEES, DUES, AND  
PAYABLE WITHIN 60 DAYS AFTER JANUARY 1 of  
any calendar year, or acquisition of a dog or  
cat by any resident, or from the date of first  
residence within the city, or from the date the  
dog or cat attains 6 months of age, the owner  
shall obtain a city license and register the  
animal as provided in Section 10-201 of this  
Ordinance. For the first 90 days of delinquency  
after the date of delinquency, a penalty of \$2.00 shall be  
charged in addition to the license fee; and for  
any period of delinquency thereafter, a  
penalty of \$10.00 shall be charged in addition  
to the license fee. For the year 1973 only, the  
license fee for cats shall be \$2.00, and the  
license fee for dogs shall remain \$5.00 per  
animal, until midnight November 30, 1973. As  
of December 1, 1973, a \$10.00 penalty shall be  
assessed in addition to the license fee, and  
other penalties as designated in Section 10-  
222 of Ordinance No. 84. This ordinance

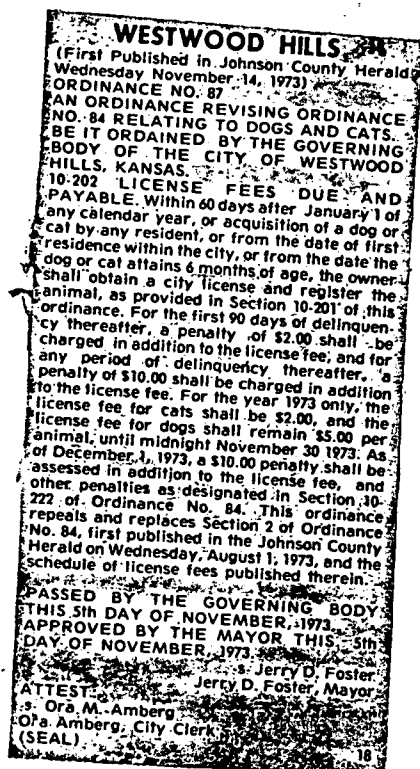

10-202 LICENSE FEES DUE AND PAYABLE. Within 60 days after  
January 1 of any calendar year, or acquisition of a dog or cat by any  
resident, or from the date of first residence within the city, or from  
the date the dog or cat attains 6 months of age, the owner shall obtain  
a city license and register the animal, as provided in Section 10-201  
of this ordinance. For the first 90 days of delinquency thereafter, a  
penalty of \$2.00 shall be charged in addition to the license fee, and for  
any period of delinquency thereafter, a penalty of \$10.00 shall be  
charged in addition to the license fee. For the year 1973 only, the  
license fee for cats shall be \$2.00, and the license fee for dogs shall  
remain \$5.00 per animal, until midnight November 30, 1973. As of  
December 1, 1973, a \$10.00 penalty shall be assessed in addition to  
the license fee, and other penalties as designated in Section 10-222 of
