WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Westwood Hills, Kansas deems it advisable and necessary, in order that this and other cities of Johnson County may adequately control and effect the identification of and the separate ordinances of said cities relating to the problems of dead and uncontrolled domestic and wild animals on the streets or roaming at large within said cities and necessary to join together with other cities to form cooperative animal control for Johnson County cities and effect for the citizens of said cities a better animal control service at the lowest possible cost to said cities, to join with other cities of Johnson County, Kansas to form a cooperative animal control Commission for Johnson County, Kansas cities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WESTWOOD HILLS, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. That the City of Westwood Hills, Kansas join with at least one (1) other adopting city to establish a Johnson County Animal Control Commission, as authorized under K.S.A. Chapter 12, Article 29.

SECTION 2. The Mayor and the City Clerk of the City of Westwood Hills, Kansas are hereby authorized, directed and empowered to execute and attest individually and collectively with other adopting cities, an agreement providing for the cooperative establishment of the Johnson County Animal Control Commission, said agreement to be substantially as set out hereinafter, to-wit:

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its official publication.
